## Day on the Hill — July 19, 2017

### Roles and Responsibilities of State Leads for Day on the Hill

- ◆ Recruit members from your state to attend the conference and participate in our day of advocacy on Capitol Hill.
  - ⇒ Make sure they register for the Day on the Hill (DOTH) on our conference webpage: [www.nnstoy.org/nc2017](http://www.nnstoy.org/nc2017).
  - ⇒ Get a list of STOYs and Finalists from your state from Lauren Cantell (Lauren@nnstoy.org)
- ◆ Facilitate organization of those attending DOTH from your state:
  1. If there are more than five from your state attending, break into smaller teams so that you can travel together in groups of 2-5.
  2. Determine which Members of Congress each group will see.
  3. Decide who will make the appointments for DOTH. (View the video “How to Make an Appointment with a Member of Congress”: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=T5V10XeCWww&t=39s>)
- ◆ Familiarize yourself and your team with the NNSTOY talking points (soon to be published as the video “NNSTOY Talking Points”) and think about how our issues play out in your state. You will have time to organize as a team at the conference to solidify your talking points and decide who will say what.
